### □ Overview

A Global Gender Policy was adopted by the WGTO AGM this June. Needless to say, a larger part of the Policy is a reflection of the Gender Policy proposed by the Regional Working group in Asia. Now, the time has come when members need to internalize the Policy and with that objective in mind, the Asia Fair Trade Summit has dedicated a full session on the WFTO Gender Policy. It is an excellent opportunity to discuss and identify practical ways in which the Gender Policy needs to be adopted, implemented and monitored like other WFTO standards in the GS, at the level of member organizations.
